



TKF PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

Due to high demand and limited space availability, we kindly ask you to consider the application requirements below:

Stakeholders invited include experts and players who contribute a role in the built environment system who possess:

- The scientific, technological, industrial and/ or practical knowledge and experience to identify the causes and the potential solutions for challenges within the built environment.
- The decision-making power to drive, implement and/ or scale the changes needed to create a sustainable built environment system.
- The financial or other resources to implement, scale or accelerate solutions identified.

In short, all attendees must be identifiable as a key part of the problem and/ or a solution. Invited participants include: architects, designers, environmental NGOs, philanthropists, real estate developers, policy-makers, material scientists, material companies, academics, investors, artists, innovators etc.

Participants who are not personally invited, are invited to apply to attend and after application are selected on the basis of the following criteria:

- The individual/ organisation possesses the requisite knowledge/ experience and/ or resources outlined above;
- The individual possesses sufficient decision-making power in his/ her organisation to be able to implement any commitments made whilst in Klosters;
- The individual/ organisation demonstrates a willingness to collaborate and act to play a part in the systemic change needed;

In order to keep the balance and proportionate representation of stakeholders, the numbers in each category of stakeholders will be capped.
